- ▶ Online, e-portfolio created by candidate, similar to PLAR – “show what you know”
- ▶ Joint Venture with The Canadian Labour Congress and with partnership of Canadian Armed Forces
- ▶ Certification issued by CME and CLC
- ▶ In English and French


## Path to Certification


**1** Candidate completes online self-assessment at certwork.com and submits it to Registrar 

 Self-assessment is scored and Registrar informs candidate whether she or he is eligible to continue with certification process **2**

**3** Registrar sends letter to candidate accepting or rejecting into program 

 Candidate is now eligible to start working on collecting the evidence to match the performance indicators in their Assessment Plan. **4**

**5** The Assessor evaluates candidate's evidence to determine if the candidate qualifies for certification 

 Candidates who meet all certification requirements will be awarded the certificate by the Registrar **6**
